# What are the changes?

- Updated Foundational Focus Areas
- Moved to2-4-8-GatekeeperScoring Methodology
- Enhanced the requirements introduced through last revision
- Updated Distribution Management concept requirements
- Removed duplication of requirements

\*Version 5.0 slated to go live early in the fourth quarter.

#### Why did URAC make these changes?

We listened to clients and expert stakeholders and addressed their comments to make the programs more streamlined and meaningful.



#### Accreditation takes too long

- Reduced number of required submissions by 50%
- Reduced accreditation timeframe to approximately six months



### URAC requirements overlap with Board of Pharmacy (BOP) requirements (duplication of work)

Removed duplicate BOP requirements



#### **Distribution Management is too complex**

- Moved Distribution Management concepts to its own Focus Area
- Promoted auditing of Distribution Management processes



## Alignment between all pharmacy programs is lacking

- Updated Foundational Focus Areas to align with other programs
- Updated Specialty Pharmacy, Mail Service Pharmacy and Specialty Pharmacy Services Programs, while utilizing other programs' structure for alignment
