Standard CR 1: Credentialing Program

The organization implements a credentialing program designed to assure that a network of qualified providers is available to provide care to members.

The organization implements policies and processes critical to assuring a quality provider network. [M]

Credentialing Committee

- Non-employed network practitioner
- Final authority



CR 2-1: Credentialing Program Policy

Approved credentialing criteria

Review and approval of credentialing application

Recredentialing every three years



Only approved practitioners are listed.

CR 3-4: Credentialing Time Frame



Dated within 180 calendar days of review by the credentialing committee:

- Credentialing application
- Primary source verification information



CR 3-5: Notification of Credentialing Decision

Written notification:



• Within 30 calendar days or per applicable law/regulation (whichever is less)*



≻This verification process could be automated.




CR 3-8: Credentialing Delegation Oversight

Report on delegated credentialing to the credentialing committee on an annual basis




