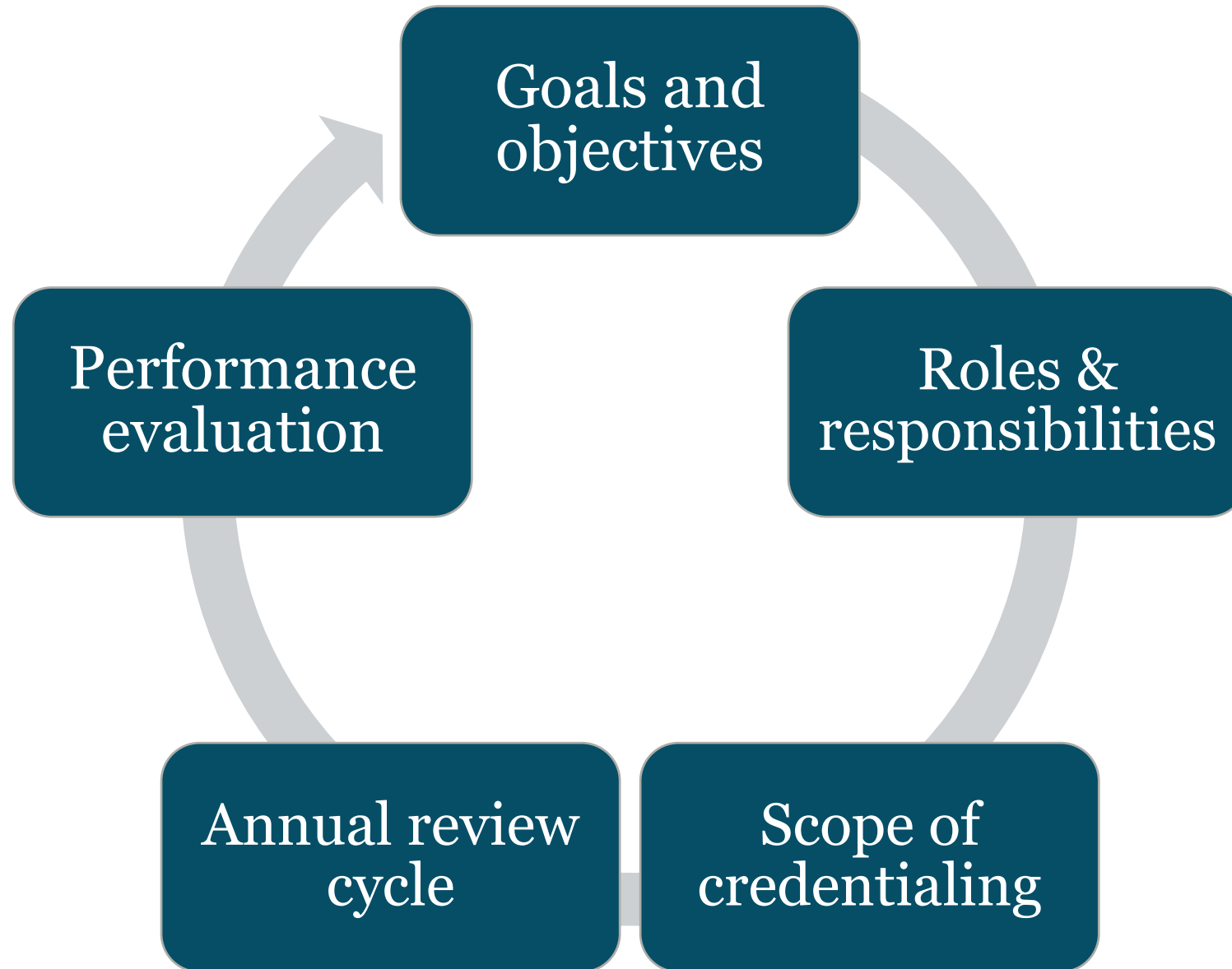

Standard CR 1: Credentialing Program

The organization implements a credentialing program designed to assure that a network of qualified providers is available to provide care to members.

CR 1-1: Credentialing Program Structure



Standard CR 2: Credentialing Requirements

The organization implements policies and processes critical to assuring a quality provider network. [M]

CR 2-1: Credentialing Program Policy



Credentialing Committee

- Non-employed network practitioner
- Final authority

CR 2-1: Credentialing Program Policy



Approved credentialing criteria



Review and approval of credentialing application



Recredentialing every three years

Only approved practitioners are listed.



Standard CR 3: Credentialing Process

Credentialing processes are well defined, timely and support the quality and safety of covered health services.

CR 3-4: Credentialing Time Frame



Dated within 180 calendar days of review by the credentialing committee:

- Credentialing application
- Primary source verification information

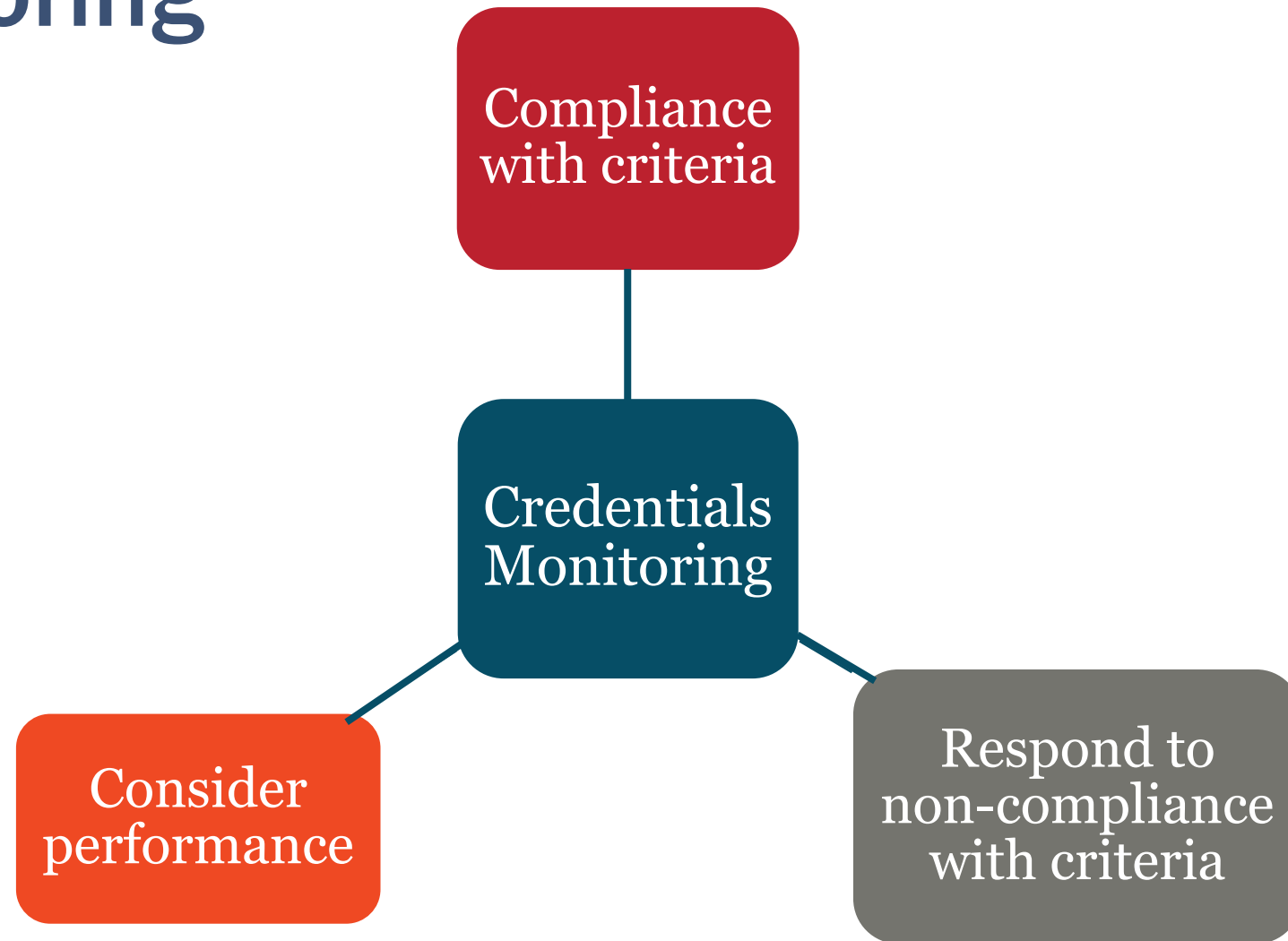
CR 3-5: Notification of Credentialing Decision

Written notification:

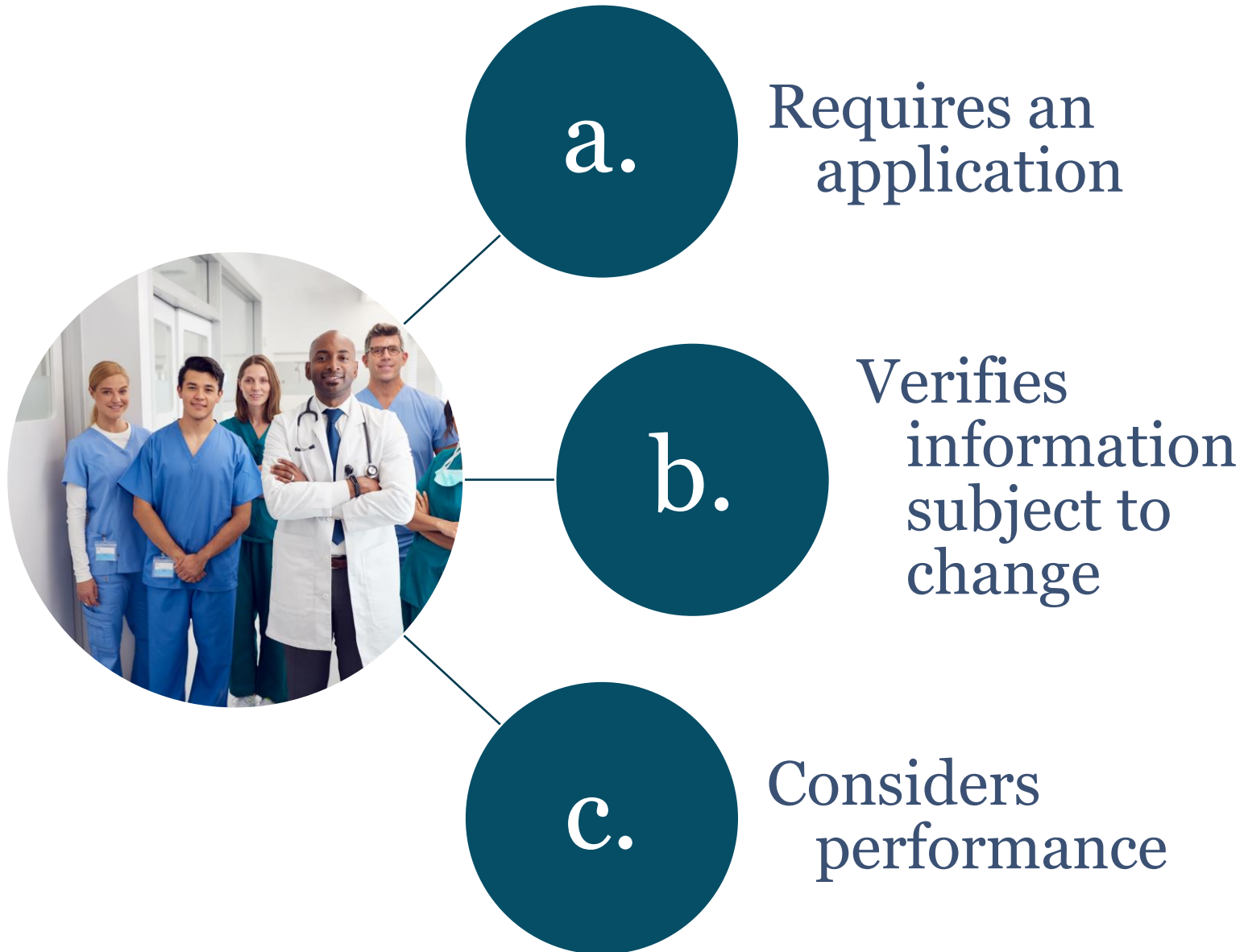
- To providers
- Within 30 calendar days or per applicable law/regulation (whichever is less)*

*change from previous element of performance

CR 3-6: Participating Provider Credentials Monitoring

CR 3-8: Credentialing Delegation Oversight

Previously not approved or removed from network participation?

- Verify prior to listing the practitioner in your provider directory.
- This verification process could be automated.



CR 3-8: Credentialing Delegation Oversight

Report on delegated credentialing to the credentialing committee on an annual basis



If delegated entity/contractor is **not** URAC-accredited for credentialing, conduct file audits:

Frequency

- Conducted on an annual basis

Sample Size

- Minimum sample size is fifteen (15) files

File Types

- **Seven** credentialing files
- **Eight** re-credentialing files
