




# **Specialty Base**

- Specialty Pharmacy (SPP) was be the main program revised
- All other programs are associated with this program

Mail Service Pharmacy (MSP) focuses on the distribution components incorporated into SPP

Specialty Pharmacy Services (SPS) focuses on the patient management components incorporated into SPP







## **Structure Changes – SPS/MSP/SPS**

Moved to 2-4-8-G Scoring Methodology

> Front matter includes information on scoring methodology

Reduced Accreditation Timeline to Six Months

Reduced # of required submissions by 50%

Removed duplicate requirements with State Boards of Pharmacy Distribution Management is a Separate Focus Area

> This is no longer a part of Pharmacy Operations

Aligned Pharmacy Programs

> Updated Foundational Focus Areas

Updated many programs at once to ensure alignment of structure and requirements where appropriate

Aligned with Specialty Pharmacy and Specialty Pharmacy Services Accreditations

Migrated from a Designation to a Certification



Moved to 2-4-8-G Scoring Methodology


