





Consumer Protection and Empowerment

CPE 2-2: Consumer Safety Protocols The organization maintains consumer safety protocols to respond, on an urgent basis, to situations that pose an immediate threat to the health and safety of consumers.



Pharmacy Operations

P-OPS 5-3: Manufacturer and FDA Requirements The pharmacy:

a. Identifies and implements Food and Drug Administration (FDA) guidance and self-imposed manufacturer requirements and promotes ongoing compliance.

b. Notifies patients and prescribers of a new FDA guidance or self-imposed manufacturer restriction that could cause a potential safety event.

P-MD 2-3: Handling Breakdowns
